Temporary Change to Bowel Preparation Product Coverage

There is a reported shortage of certain manufacturers of polyethylene glycol 3350 with electrolytes (PEG-3350) used for bowel preparation used for colonoscopy procedures. There is no identified resolution date for this shortage.

To assist our Molina Healthcare of Michigan **Medicaid members** with obtaining the necessary medications, Molina will **temporarily** allow the following products to be filled at the pharmacy without the need for prior authorization effective immediately.

Again, this is a temporary change to assist members and providers due to the shortage of PEG-3350. Molina is monitoring the availability of PEG-3350 with electrolytes. We will notify providers when the shortage is resolved, and the prior authorization is reinstated for the medications **bolded** in the table above.
