Preventive Health Guidelines Update July 13, 2023 (Medicaid, Marketplace, Medicare)

Preventive Health Guidelines (PHG) can benefit providers and their patients. Guidelines are based on scientific evidence, review of the medical literature, or appropriately established authority, as cited. All recommendations are based on published consensus guidelines and do not favor any particular treatment based solely on cost considerations. These guidelines are meant to recommend a standard level of care and do not preclude the delivery of additional preventive services depending on the individual needs of the patient.
